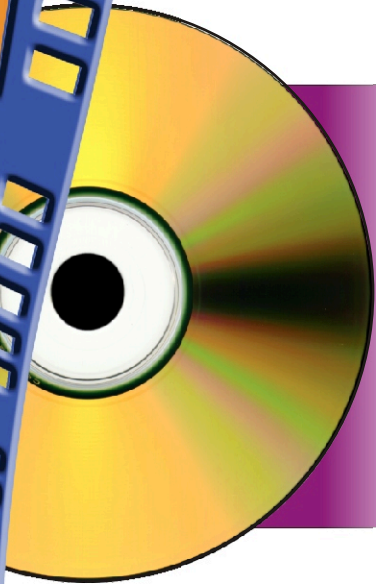

We can take most video, digital and film formats, including VHS, Hi-8, Mini-DV, Betacam, 8mm, Super-8 & 16mm film, and encode it to DVD digital video or CD-ROM. We can then scan your support documents, index them and add them to the Archive Disc allowing you to keep all your videos and documents in one easy-to-carry package. Using our video and computer technology, we have created a custom, very user friendly interface that allows you to view and search through the video, access ASCII, PDF or Microsoft Word format documents, create bookmarks to access only the sections you wish to view and display the video on projection or large-screen TV's. Archive Disc is ideal for the permanent storage of valuable materials in a digital format that takes up a fraction of the space of the original. It is an ideal medium for preventing damage to or loss of the original materials during transportation or handling. The discs can be easily copied and distributed to research students, educational institutions, museums and others.

Our Archive Disc Service includes:

CD-ROM is best for short presentations where your support documents, transcripts and videos will not exceed 650 megabytes.

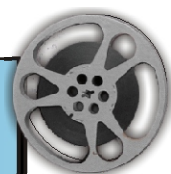
